SCHOLARSHIP Fund Rules

CWA, Local 4108 has established a "Scholarship Fund" for the benefit of its members and their families.

The 27th annual Scholarship Awards will be awarded at the August 2010 Executive Board Meeting. There will be two (2) scholarships of \$1,000.00 each.

Checks will be issued to attending colleges or universities of the winners. He or she will apply to the college or university bursar for credit toward tuition, fees, books, supplies and equipment for courses which may be required to be paid by the student. The student is not permitted cash withdrawals and if the student leaves the university before the scholarship is completely used, the balance is returned to the CWA Scholarship Fund.

*Eligibility:*

To be eligible for a Local 4108 Scholarship Award, you must meet the following requirements.

The applicant must be either:

1. A member or retired member of CWA, Local 4108.
2. The husband, wife, or dependent son or daughter of a member of Local 4108.
3. The husband, wife, or dependent son or daughter of a retired member of Local 4108.
4. The husband, wife, or dependent son or daughter of a deceased member of Local 4108.

Member, for the purpose of this scholarship means either:

1. Active Members - members in good standing at the time the application is submitted and thereafter.
2. Retired Members - members in good standing at the time of their retirement.
3. Deceased Members - members in good standing at the time of their death.

The applicant must also be either:

1. A college student (full-time) working towards a degree at an accredited college or University.
2. A High School student, graduate, or G.E.D. Equivalent who has been accepted at an accredited college or university.

The drawing will be held, unless otherwise posted, at the local office, in August 2010 at the Executive Board Meeting. Two (2) \$1,000.00 scholarships and one (1) Alternate will be drawn.

A winner who is found to not meet the rules of the Fund will be disqualified and a qualified alternate will then take the Scholarship.
